

What does each service do?

Social Care – (Hands-off)

Medication reminders, grooming guidance, hobbies, activities, meal prep and feeding, in-home tasks to help with activities of daily living and helping the client feel safe at home. Memory care supervision, conversation and companionship. Call 911 in case of emergency.

Certified Home Care – (Hands on)

Assist with self-care such as grooming, bathing, hygiene care, dressing and toileting. Food prep and feeding, light housekeeping (i.e. making bed, dishes after meals, tidying up behind client). Memory care supervision and laundry assistance, all while providing meaningful conversation and companionship. Call 911 in case of emergency.

Nursing Care – (Hands on)

Ambulation, transferring, medication assistance and fall prevention. Monitoring of fluids, glucose levels and vitals. Provide nursing care. Ability to assist those with chronic diseases as well as Dementia and Alzheimer's. Call 911 in case of emergency.

Registered Nursing Care – (Hands on)

Initial patient evaluation and monitoring of physician orders. Care for those with chronic diseases and conditions such as TBI, ALS, MS, and Vent, Trach, Ostomy, Feeding Tube and Catheter Care. Vitals monitoring and all patient reassessments. Any emergent issues that arise. Call 911 in case of emergency.
